

Finding a Plain Text File: Seeing Ear

This guide covers finding books in Plain Text format from The Seeing Ear. Search and download one book of your choice.

The Seeing Ear, <http://www.seeingear.org/>

The Seeing Ear is an online electronic library of (mainly fiction) books. The books are made and shared under the terms of conditions of the CLA VIP licence and can be accessed by people who are visually impaired or physically unable to use printed works. The library is free to join.

1. Go to the Seeing Ear web site and click on **The Library**.
2. Click on the library you want to use.
3. Log in with your username and password.
4. Search for the book you want by author, title or category.
5. Once you have found your book, right click to download the file to your computer. Save it in My Documents.
6. Go to My Documents, find the book, right-click on it, and Open it with MS Word.
