### Creating a Clicker 5 Jukebox Page

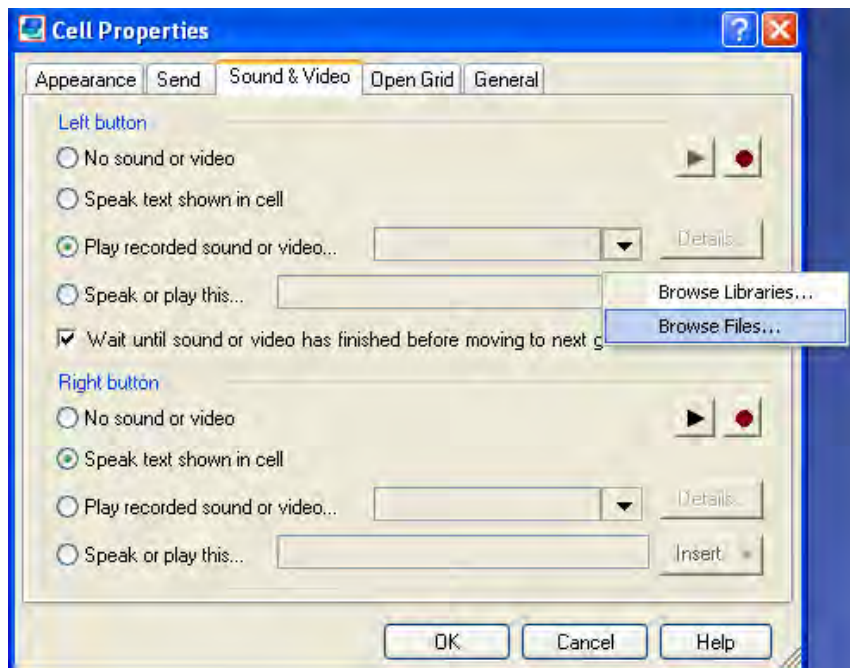
- Create clips of favourite music tracks using a program like 'Audacity.'
- Export the tracks as Wav files, as this is a format that Clicker 5 can handle, and save them together in a folder.
- Also save digital images for the songs you are going to use e.g. from Google Images, and keep them together in a folder too.
- Open Clicker 5, select 'Create new Grid Set.'
- Select 'Blanks' 'Blank grids' 'nonsending.'
- Select 'Create.'
- Press 'File' 'Save Grid Set As' and name it e.g. High School Musical 1
- In 'Edit Mode' create the number of 'music cells' you would like on your Jukebox Page.

### Programming a Jukebox Cell

In 'Edit Mode' right click on the cell you want to modify.

- Select 'Properties.'
- Select 'Choose Picture' and 'Browse Files' to find your **pre-saved** digital image for that song.
- Double Click on it to insert it.
- Then type the name of the song into the text label area.





- Now select the 'Sound and Video' tab.
- Select 'play recorded sound or video' and then 'Browse Files.'
- Find your saved music clip e.g. from 'My Music.'
- Double click on it to insert it and press OK.
- Your cell should now have a digital image and the name of the track on it and when you select it, your music clip will play.
- Continue in the same way to record the rest of your Jukebox page.
- Remember to 'Save Grid Set' as you go along.

**Remember:** the music clips are now embedded in the Clicker 5 grid, so this makes it a very large file.
