## Modifying a Button

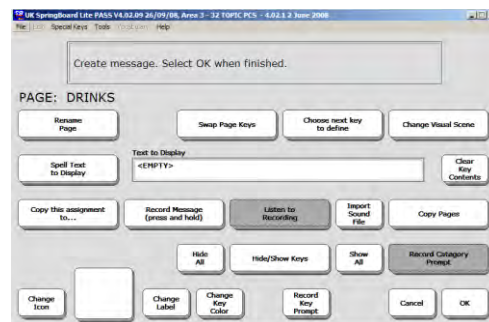
### 1. Finding the button

- Press the 'Tools' icon button
- Select 'Full Toolbox'
- Select 'Modify Page'
- Find the page you wish to modify
- Select the button you wish to programme/modify

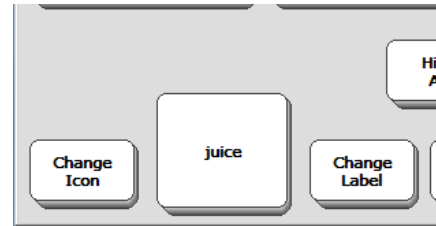


### 2. Modifying the button

- Select 'spell text to display'
- Type in what you'd like the written message from the button to be e.g. "juice" or "I'd like juice"
- Press OK
- Select 'record message' (press and hold the button down whilst speaking the message into the microphone) e.g. I'd like juice
- You can press 'listen to recording' to check you are happy with how it sounds



- At the bottom of the page select 'change icon' so you can choose a suitable picture/symbol for the button
- You can find the icon by category or you can just select 'spell icon to find'



- Type in the name of the picture you want e.g. juice
- Select OK
- Choices will then appear on the screen.
- Select a picture by pressing it,
- Check the 'label' on the button is correct
- If it is not, press 'change label' and change the label yourself
- Press OK



- If you wish to continue modifying more buttons on this page select 'choose next key to define' and repeat the process for the next button you wish to change
- Once you are finished with the page, just press OK until you are back at the 'Top Page'
- If you wish to clear an entire button, go into 'Tools', find it, select it to modify, then press 'clear key contents' (this can also be used if you make some errors and want to start from scratch with the button you're working on)
- You can then go to the 'drinks' page to try out your new button(s)
