

PAID FOR AUDIO BOOKS

*These companies are only **some** of those which offer a range of modern and classic texts on Audio CD or MP3, all using human readers. Some are subscription where you are committed to purchasing a set number of books but there are advantages in the special offers they have and the excellent prices that they claim. Others you purchase as normal. Delivery charges vary, some have sample audio to listen before you buy, one has a rental scheme, another a trading option. Note that many 'High Street' bookshops and music shops also sell audio books.*

Over 13,000 audio books available for download. Individual books are discounted or you can sign up to download one book per month for £7.99 or two books a month at £14.99. Free iPod Shuffle if you sign up for a year.

RNIB sell Daisy audio books, which are often cheaper than a commercial MP3 version. E.g. Charlie and the Chocolate Factory is £5.99 (read by David Thorpe) compared to £9 for an MP3 version from audible.co.uk (read by Eric Idle).

Simply Audio books

This company offers Audio CDs and downloads with subscription packages for purchase or rental. Free audio books are available through the "audiobook download of the month program". You need to join then choose your subscription: downloads cost £6.95 for 1, £12.95 for 2, £17.95 for 3; rentals are £5.95 for 1, £11.95 for 2 selections at a time in any one month, but as soon as the book is returned you can order another one/two.

LIBRARIES AND CHARITIES

Calibre Audio Library and Young Calibre

Free postal service for adults and children with print disabilities. 8,000 audio books; 1,400 children's books. All members can borrow books on MP3 CD while only the visually impaired can borrow audio cassettes. No charge. 2 books can be borrowed at a time.

Listening Books: The National Listening Library

National charity supporting pupils and schools. Library of over 1000 titles of audio books for children. Yearly membership: £45 (2 CDs at any one time, and Internet download); £30 (CDs only); £20 (download only). Schools can also take out membership - if you want to borrow more than 2 CDs at a time it can cost more - contact the Library for details.

Over 14,000 titles on Daisy audio CD (requires a specialised Daisy MP3 player). You can join if "you live in the UK and cannot read ordinary print (standard typescript N12 or less) at normal reading distance using glasses". It costs £50 per year if you have your own Daisy player, or £73 a year for which you get a Daisy player on loan. (Local authorities may pay the subscription.) You can have 6 books on loan at a time. RNIB also have a new BookStream book club where you can download Daisy audio books and listen to them with Daisy playback software on your computer.

School and Local Authority Libraries

School and local authority libraries often have (and if they don't, they should) a good range of commercial audio books on CD.

FREE AUDIO BOOKS

Newspapers and magazines often give away audio book CDs. The sites below generally offer books which are out of copyright or which authors have specifically made available in audio format for free. The text version for many of these is available for free download at the Project Gutenberg website http://www.gutenberg.org/wiki/Main_Page. You can create your own audio version (computer voice) with suitable software.
