Focus of workshop

- Update regarding the evidence-base for paediatric powered mobility
- Exploring access methods & use of a framework for selecting access method
- Outcome measures: inc. case studies, driving skills tests, participation measures
- Powered mobility training

This 1-day Powered Mobility workshop will be facilitated by Ros Livingstone & Debbie Field from the Sunny Hill Health Centre for Children, Vancouver, Canada. Ros & Debbie will be at this year's European Seating Symposium where they are presenting papers, and have kindly agreed to extend their stay to run this one-off course. (Ros is already known to many therapists in Scotland having previously worked in the UK, as part of the Paediatric Occupational Therapy Service, NHS Lothian where she was involved in developing the use of technology and powered mobility within the special schools team.)
