AAC Participation Plan

A one-page planning sheet to help you select vocabulary to model, which addresses various language functions within everyday routines.

AAC Activities Plan

This resource allows you to take a preferred toy or activity and think about how you can target different language functions within it.



Chat Editor / Pass Software

This free software allows you to replicate vocabularies from either our NovaChat and Via devices and TouchChat and LAMP WFL apps (Chat Editor) or our Accent Devices (PASS Software). Perfect to learn vocabularies, model language or create teaching resources. You can load in a person's vocabulary so you can edit it away from their device.
