

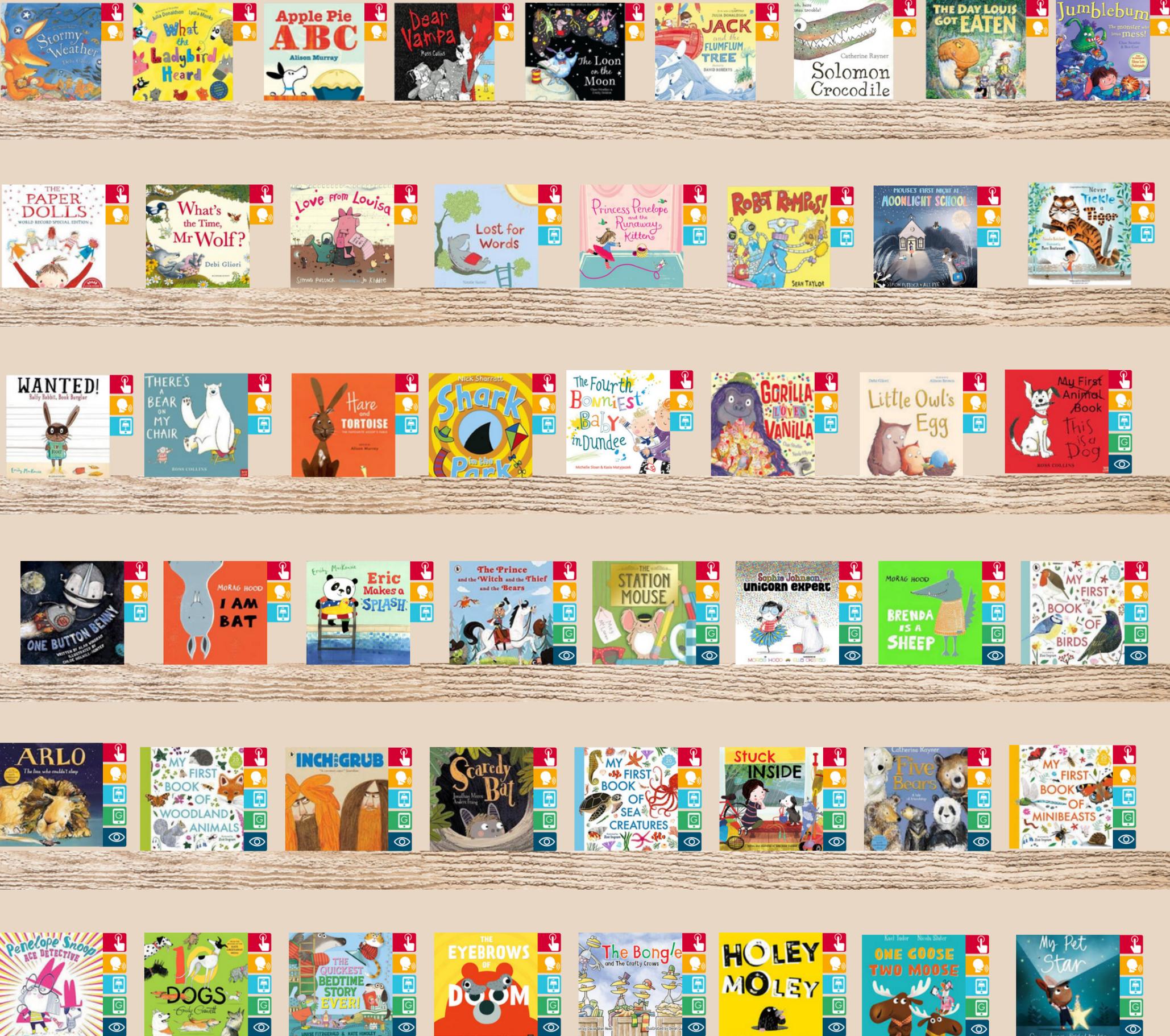
# Bookbug Digital Bookshelf 2026

These books have all been included in the Primary 1 Family Bags distributed each year by Scottish Book Trust. CALL Scotland has worked with Scottish Book Trust, the authors and publishers to create Accessible Copies of these books so that learners with print disabilities can read and participate. Professionals working in schools in Scotland can create a free account on [booksforall.org.uk](http://booksforall.org.uk) and download these books for their learners with print disabilities.

Print disabilities can include people with physical, sensory or learning difficulties. The digital files are available as PowerPoint, Keynote, Grid 3 and Grid for iPad files. Click on the icon tabs down the side of the books to download the files.
