Apps and Extensions

ChromeBooks primarily use apps and extensions, available from: chromewebstore.google.com/.

Apps are the equivalent of programs on an Apple or Windows computer. A small number of apps are pre-installed on the Chromebook, but most are run within your Chrome Browser. Some of the 'apps' also include web based programs.

Built-in Accessibility tools
