



Creating a video choice board using PowerPoint



1. To create a simple choice board with clickable images which open videos, create a blank PowerPoint.
2. Insert the first image by clicking on *Insert* then *Pictures*




3. Click on the image to select it. Click *Insert*.



4. Repeat for the other images.
5. Create a blank slide for each image. These slides will link and play the YouTube videos. E.g. if you have inserted 3 images, create 3 blank slides.


6. Right click on the first slide to quickly create a new blank slide.




7. Insert duplicate blank slides by clicking *Duplicate Slide*.

8. Click on the first blank slide. This is where you will insert the first YouTube video.

Click *Insert* ,then *Video/Online Video*




A box pops up asking for a URL




Creating a video choice board using PowerPoint

- Open up a webpage, go to www.YouTube.com and search for the video which you want to play when your learner selects the first image.

Right click in the URL at the top of the screen. Copy the link.



- Go back to the PowerPoint and right click to paste the URL into the box. Click *Insert*




- You can click on the video and drag out the corners to make it larger. Make sure to right click on the video and select *Start Automatically*.



Creating a video choice board using PowerPoint


12. Click on *Insert* and select *Shapes*.

Scroll down to the bottom and select *Action Button Blank*.




13. Draw a giant Action Button so it covers the slide.

Click *Hyperlink To/First Slide*. Click *OK*.



14. To make the button invisible right click. Select *Format Shape*.




15. Slide the transparency slider to the right to make the button 100% transparent. Repeat for each video slide.



16. Go back to the first slide. Right click on the first image. Click *Link*.



17. Click *Place in This Document* and select the relevant slide with corresponding YouTube video. Click OK. Repeat for each image on the first page.



18. You can now the slideshow into play mode by pressing F5. Clicking on the images will open a page which will play a video. To close the video and go back to the first page, click anywhere on the screen.
