

Top 10 Tips for Digital Bookbug Storytime





- 1. Check that the Author video and the SoundingBoard file are both working and ready to use.
- 2. Find a quiet comfy space to read together.
- 3. Have the digital book/hard copy ready, along with the SoundingBoard on your iOS device
- 4. Look at the SoundingBoard together. Talk about each picture symbol, naming the characters and explaining what each word means whilst pointing to the symbol.
- 5. Remind your child that they have a 'turn the page' button for when they are ready to move on and an 'again' button to hear a page or part of the story again.
- 6. Watch the Author video once through together, listening and engaging in the story, without asking specific questions.
- 7. Read the story again. As you listen to the story, you can use the Space bar on your PC or the play/pause button on the tablet screen to pause the story, as appropriate. This will give your child time to comment or respond to a question about the story, using the symbols.
- 8. To encourage your child to respond, 'model' use of the symbols by pointing to them and using them yourself. You could also use a puppet or favourite cuddly toy to 'model' the communication.
- 9. Respond positively to whatever your child tries to communicate during the story time, this is a special time to spend together and should be as relaxed as possible.
- 10.Enjoy being close and connected to your child and remember, stories are fun! Enjoy yourselves ©
